

# Waste Separation - STADT OBERHAUSEN - Waste Separation



RESIDUAL WASTE
Dustbins have to be put on the pavement till 7 o'clock in the morning at the day of clearance
EXAMPLES
food residues
ash
dishes, video cassettes
tissues
odds of wallpapers, textiles
cotton sticks, sanitary pads
cat litter, toys
frying pans, pots, toothbrushes
glas pane, nappies
photos, films, bulbs
If the dustbin does not be sufficient, municipal rubbish bags can be used. These are available at the local town houses. Municipal rubbish bags will be collected on the day of clearance of the dustbins.
DON'T PUT IN
electrical waste (e.g. mobiles)
toxic substances (e.g. used oil, paint, gloss paint)
building rubble

ORGANIC WASTE
Please wrap wet organic waste in newspapers
EXAMPLES
leftovers of fruits and vegetables
cuts of leaves, trees and bushes
lawn cuttings
flowers and flower soil
coffee grounds and filters
tea bags
eggshells
plants
weeds
Bins for organic waste (Biotonne) are provided for a fee in the sizes of 80 litres, 120 litres and 240 litres. When using a bin for bio-waste it is possible to reduce the necessary volume of the dustbin. From 4 persons on a fee reduction is possible.
DON'T PUT IN
ash, cat litter
vacuum cleaner bag, nappies
food residues, fish, meat

PAPER / CARDBOARD
Please flat fold cartons and packaging or tear them
EXAMPLES
newspapers, magazines
cartons
catalogues
cardboards
brochures, booklets
writing paper, books, diaries
packagings of paper
paper bags
The blue bin for the collection of paper is available for free in the sizes of 120 litres, 240 litres and 1.100 litres. In the urban area there are 30 sites with paper and glass containers. Paper can also be dispensed at the Wertstoffhof, Buschhausener Str. 144
DON'T PUT IN
coatet paper, document files
vacuum cleaner bag, nappies
dirty papers, wallpapers

PACKAGING
Packagings of composite material, metal and plastic
EXAMPLES
yoghurt- and margarine tubs
juice- and detergent bottles
plastic bags, foils
styrofoam trays for fruits
styrofoam trays for vegetables
aluminium foils, -lids, -skins
bottle tops, tetrapacks
cans for drinks or canned fruits
cartons for milk- and juice
The yellow bin for the collection of packaging is available for free in the sizes of 240 litres and 1.100 litres. It's also possible to use yellow bags, which are available for free in the local town houses.
DON'T PUT IN
glass bottles, glasses
packagings of paper or carton
plastic buckets, plastic bowls

GLASS
Please separate white, green and brown glass
EXAMPLES
juice bottles, wine bottles
jam jars
jars for canned food
cooking oil bottles
champagne bottles
liqueur bottles
Throughout the urban area there are glass container for disposal. Please don't throw the lids of the jars into the container. They belong to the yellow bin or yellow bag. Blue glass belongs into the container for green glass.
DON'T PUT IN
leaded crystal, bulb
mirror glass, pane of glass
pottery, porcelain, glass block
